We will celebrate the 40th Anniversary of the First Scotland Week in New York, which took place from November 11th - 18th 1974. Instituted by Lady Douglas-Hamilton, Chairman of the Foundation, she declared "Scotland Week marks the first official week-long celebration of Scottish-American ties and ...will be an annual event in the future". In subsequent years, following Congressional, Senate and Presidential decree, April 6 was designated Tartan Day leading to week long festivities of Scottish American people, culture and heritage. We will toast Lady Douglas-Hamilton for her vision.

Claudio Del Vecchio
