Friends of Van Cortlandt Park

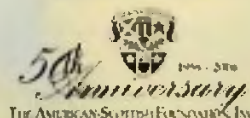

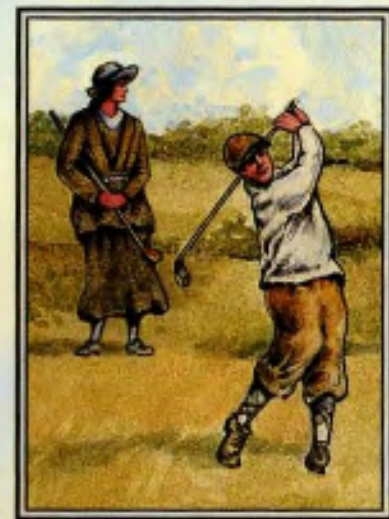

- ☞ Entry Fee must be submitted with application. American Express, MasterCard & Visa accepted or make checks payable to THE AMERICAN-SCOTTISH FOUNDATION.
- ☞ The fee includes: greens fee, parking, shared motor cart, awards, luncheon, on-course snack, tee-prizes, and awards dinner, including entertainment, and single malt scotch tasting.
- ☞ U.S.G.A. rules will govern play.
- ☞ Scramble format will be used.
- ☞ Awards: Hole-in-One; Team – First, Second, Grass, & Net, Mens and Womens; Closest to Pin, Longest Drive, and Straightest Drive; Scottish Schools and/or Universities Challenge.
