### **1. BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

The Board of Directors now includes members from Chicago, Illinois and Washington D.C.

### **2. BUSINESS FORUM**

Three Business Forums have been conducted that have drawn significant audiences and have provided platforms for distinguished speakers.

### **3. CARNEGIE CENTENNIAL CELEBRATIONS**

The inaugural celebration took place in December, 2002.

Centennials are planned to coincide with the opening of the remaining 35 branch libraries that were funded through Andrew Carnegie's generosity.

Over the next five years, the Foundation plans to sponsor these celebrations and feature symposiums to highlight specific aspects of his legacy.

### **4. HONORARY SPONSORS**

Already appointed, and have guided the Foundation's Board relative to both its activities in Scotland and to Scottish organizations.

### **5. SCOTLAND HOUSE**

The Board has endorsed the long range goal of developing a permanent home for Scotland House. The awareness of the benefits of such a venue is seen in the increasing number of similar national 'homes' that have been created by others.

The President of the Foundation continues to be a driving force in the professionalization of this group.
