



- Lady Natalie Douglas-Hamilton remained President Emerita of the Foundation until her death in 2013










Bursary and Education Programs

- Enabling school groups, dance groups and performers to travel to Scottish festivals or come to NYC










Community: The ARCHIE Foundation







A Bridge for Scotland in the Arts


- ASF is working with the Public Catalogue Foundation, which is undertaking the cataloging of 30,000 public works in Scotland






